
Superficies licences

- wind farms, fish farms, algae farms, marine cables, marine pipes etc.
- water body but does not have a permanent

CPTRA issues superficies licences for offshore

 'Superficies licence' means a right to encumber, for a specified period of time, a delimited part of a public water body with a construction work that is permanently connected to the bottom of the connection to the shore. Valid for up to 50 years.

Permitting process

Other permits needed:

- Environmental permit for special use of water (water) permit) – Environmental Board
- Building permit CPTRA
- Use and occupancy permit CPTRA

In the future - single combined permit instead of 3 permits (superficies licence, water permit, building permit) in order to speed up the planning process - offshore wind farms only
